Removes the threat of civil liability from business owners who DO NOT mandate covid vaccines for employees and customers.

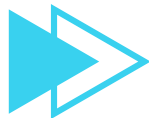

Prohibits public and nonpublic schools from requiring covid vaccinations for students.

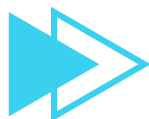

When communicating to parents about vaccine requirements, schools must inform parents of their option to submit an exemption.

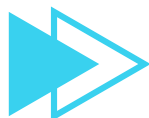

A person who is subject to an investigation by the ethics board may request in writing the name of the complainant after the conclusion of the investigation and the ethics board shall fulfill the request.

Parents Can Consent, not Minors

Makes age of majority 18.
Requires parental consent for medical or surgical care or services performed on a minor except in cases of emergency.
States that medical procedures shall not be deemed an emergency if it is an elective procedure requested or suggested by either the physician or minor.

A Voice for the Voiceless

Immunization records must be included in the autopsy report in all cases of infants under the age of one year who die unexpectedly without explanation.



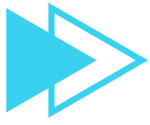

No Patient Left Alone

No hospital, nursing home, licensed nursing facility, inpatient hospice facility, or other healthcare facility shall deny visitation of members of the clergy or persons designated by any adult patient or resident in its care.
Minors shall have access to parents at all times.
Law can not be suspended during a public health emergency.

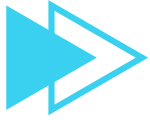

Prohibits CBD (central bank digital currency).

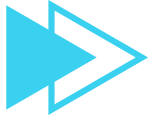

Legalizes sale of raw milk.

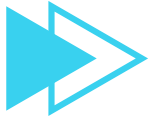


HB608

Provides for the distinction between males and females and provides for protections for women and girls against sexual assault and harassment committed by biological men.

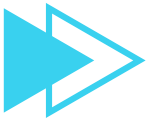


HB711

Requires prior written informed consent in person from the parent, legal guardian, or representative of the minor for the administration of each vaccine.

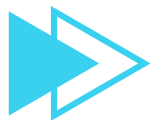

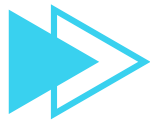

Protects a physician's right to write prescriptions off-label.

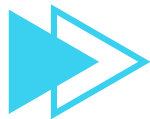


HB815

Requires LDH to follow FDA regulations relating to advertising for drugs, pharmaceuticals, and vaccine-related products.



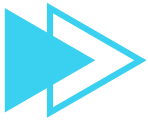

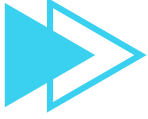


HB866

Rep. Beryl Amedee

Right to Refuse a Product under EUA or PREP

Provides a right to refuse a drug, pharmaceutical, biologic, or vaccine authorized for emergency use or considered a countermeasure under the PREP Act. Prohibits discrimination based on that refusal.

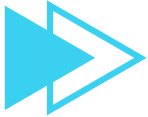


HB908

No Discrimination with an Exemption

Prohibits discrimination against students who submit an exemption to vaccine requirements.

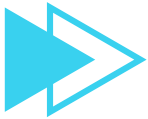


HB914

Free to Speak, Free to Bank

Prohibits financial institutions from denying or canceling services or discriminating against a person on the basis of political opinions, speech, affiliations, or religious beliefs. Prohibits use of social credit score as a factor in providing services.

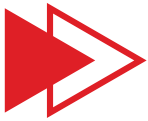

Kickbacks Are Coercive

Prohibits health insurers from incentivizing vaccination beyond the contracted reimbursement.

Amends the Children's Code to add that the purpose of the LA Children's Code is also to promote public safety.

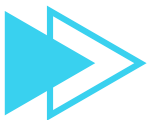

No rule, regulation, fee, tax policy, or mandate of any kind of the World Health Organization, United Nations, and the World Economic Forum shall be enforced or implemented by the state of Louisiana or any agency, department, board, commission, political subdivision, governmental entity of the state, parish, municipality, or any other political entity.
